

FESTIVAL OF SWIMMING AUGUST 2021 SWANSEA
IMPORTANT INFORMATION CLARIFICATION

Event COVID protocols are published online. These include use of Lateral Flow Test within 24 hours of arrival. This process must be completed by everyone in attendance, for each day of attendance. All attendees must evidence a negative test before they will be permitted onsite. Ideally this is in the form of the NHS test report text, however a negative lateral flow test will also be accepted and should be shown to the team on the door

- QR codes are onsite for scanning, and we advise attendees do so, however this cannot be enforced
- The site will be open from 7.30am each morning, with the team on the doors ready to receive attendees and check your negative tests (text or LFT)
- No spectators onsite
- Coaches are limited 1:20 coach:swimmer on site per session – this is to manage site numbers and ensure we stay under the capacity limit - if we're found to be over the limit the event will be shut down. Disabled swimmers will be granted a chaperone to accompany them onsite
- The event will be live streamed via the Swim Wales social media and YouTube platforms and will be free to access
- Changing facilities will be available, swimmers are required to wipe down the cubicle and locker after use. Wipes will be available to use within the facility. Although we do recommend bringing your own. These facilities must be used respectfully and sensibly or will be shut down.
- Cool down pool will be accessible during the session (under lifeguard control as clubs will not have coaches to monitor their swimmers)
- During the longer session breaks the site will need to be emptied in order for the pool to complete a full site clean. Swimmers will need to be managed by parents and/or club during this time
- Swimmers will be permitted back onto site as soon as the facility has completed their cleaning operations, this may result in an immediate warm up start, swimmers are therefore advised to arrive beach ready to maximise warm up time. Swimmers will have to show the result/text each time they enter the building, non-swimmers will have a wrist band, but swimmers won't have a wrist band.
- The virtual briefing Thursday 7-8pm will include a run through of the published information, a site brief from Swansea Club and an opportunity to ask questions. Given the number of swimmers attending we advise that this session is attended by club coach/team managers who can relay information back to swimmers and/or parents
